

Paid internships, News Services Summer and Fall 2008

Hours: Minimum of 10 hours per week; between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday – Friday.

Duties: Serve as a member of the News Services team assisting outside print and broadcast media in covering news and events on campus; working with campus communicators to gather, write, edit and post their news; updating the University's online events calendar; assisting with administrative duties as necessary; and taking on other assignments as assigned.

Requirements: Must be in news-editorial or public relations sequence. Sound command of AP style required. Must be able to write and edit well and to respond promptly and effectively to local, regional and national media contacting Carolina for help with deadline stories.
